ATR VERDICT: QUIET WORD failed to justify odds-on favouritism at Nottingham on debut in May, but Archie Watson's filly didn't appear to enjoy soft ground there and has enjoyed a 159-day break ahead of this return to action on Polytrack. A half-sister to a French 1m two-year-old winner, this step up in trip is also expected to bring about improvement. Stablemate Pepper Bay finished second over C&D on debut and is a half-sister to three winners, while Captivated could have much more to offer now following a disappointing debut 11 days ago.
